

WMAA Parent Involvement Plan

WMAA will implement a variety of programs to encourage high levels of parent involvement in their child's education. WMAA founders believe that parent involvement should be integral and visible at every level of school operations. Therefore, the Board of Directors will seek to have a parent representative on the WMAA Board at all times. The Academy Board will use a committee structure and will ask parents to serve on committees. WMAA will also actively encourage parent participation in parent-teacher conferences.

PROPS (Parent Resource Organization Providing Support) has been formed as a parent involvement group. This group will help WMAA establish parent support networks. This group will bring parents together for regularly scheduled meetings that foster discussions concerning how best to support the educational endeavors of their children. Specifically, PROPS will work to 1) keep parents informed of the educational developments at the school; 2) plan and coordinate events at the school with school staff; 3) help with school fundraising; and 4) give parents a unified voice concerning policy decisions the Academy Board faces.

WMAA will encourage ongoing involvement in the daily life of the school through numerous volunteer opportunities. WMAA also will host all-school events to bring parents/guardians on campus to witness and/or participate in student projects and presentations. WMAA will provide tours of the school facility for parents and community members.
